This year such traditions will be practised under the shadow of Covid-19; however, while mainland France begins its return to lockdown, St Barts feels extremely fortunate to be able to continue life with very few restrictions, albeit with masks and social distancing.

We start the service with the hymn A New Commandment; and then, to mark La Chorale receiving official approval to re-start rehearsals in the Church, our meditation piece is their version of Con Te Partiro. I hope you like this new version, recorded by musicians from Long Island, CT while in quarantine.


